

PROCEEDINGS OF AN EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE NATCHITOCHES PARISH
POLICE JURY OF THE PARISH OF NATCHITOCHES, STATE OF LOUISIANA,
HELD, MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2005

The Police Jury of the Parish of Natchitoches, State of Louisiana, met in an emergency session in their regular meeting place, the Police Jury Board Room of the Natchitoches Parish Courthouse, on Thursday, September 12, 2005 at seven fifty (7:50) p.m.

The invocation was given by Mr. J. D. Garrett followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Mr. Woodrow Cox.

There were present: Honorable John Salter, President, Police Jurors: Woodrow Cox, Chris Paige, J. D. Garrett, Joe Allen, Calvin Hay, Tom Collier, Jr., and Gale Potts-Roque.

There was absent: William Hymes, Charles Huggins and Joe Mitchell, Jr.

The Police Jury of the Parish of Natchitoches was then duly convened as the governing authority of said parish by the President who stated that the Police Jury was ready for the transaction of business.

President Salter then asked if there were any visitors who would like to be recognized. Since there were no visitors waiting to be recognized, President Salter then proceeded with stating the reason for this meeting. Mr. Salter stated that due to the excessive rainfall and the storm that came to the Natchitoches Parish on Monday that the many families were suffering a tremendous amount of damages. He stated that he had received a phone call from Representative Taylor Townsend who said the Jury should consider declaring Natchitoches Parish a disaster area. Relative to this, the following action was taken:

On motion by Mrs. Roque, duly seconded by Mr. Allen, that the Natchitoches Parish Police Jury, in an emergency session convened, does hereby declare a state of emergency in Natchitoches Parish due to the excessive rainfall and recent storm.
