

PROCEEDINGS OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
NATCHITOCHES PARISH POLICE JURY HELD THURSDAY,
SEPTEMBER 7, 2006

3:30 P.M.

The Police Jury of the Parish of Natchitoches, State of Louisiana, met in special session in the Police Jury Board Room of the Natchitoches Parish Courthouse, on Thursday, September 7, 2006 at three thirty (3:30) p.m.

The invocation was given by Juror Tom Collier followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Juror William Hymes.

There were present: Honorable Alice Barrios, President, Police Jurors Joey Cox, Chris Paige, J. D. Garrett, William Hymes, Charles Huggins, Charles Cloud, Tom Collier, Jr. and Gale Potts-Roque.

There was absent: Jessie Hoffpauir and Doug Masters.

President Barrios then asked Jurors Tom Collier and Chris Paige to please come forward. Mr. Collier then presented Mrs. Alice Barrios a check from the Martin Foundation in the amount of \$5,000.00 to support the Disability Ramp Program. Mr. Collier stated that he and Mr. Bobby Deen had contacted Mr. Martin to donate materials for the building of the ramps and was offered the monetary donation. Mr. Collier stated that he would like to personally thank the Martin Foundation for their contribution.
