

PROCEEDINGS OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
NATCHITOCHE PARISH POLICE JURY HELD THURSDAY,
DECEMBER 11, 2006

3:00 P.M.

The Police Jury of the Parish of Natchitoches, State of Louisiana, met in special session in the Police Jury Board Room of the Natchitoches Parish Courthouse, on Monday, December 11, 2006, at three (3:00) o'clock p.m.

The invocation was given by Juror Chris Paige followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Juror Charlie Huggins.

There were present: Honorable Alice Barrios, President, Police Jurors Joey Cox, Chris Paige, J. D. Garrett, Charles Huggins, Charles Cloud, Tom Collier, Jessie Hoffpauir, Doug Masters and Gale Potts-Roque.

There was absent: William Hymes.

President Barrios then stated that the purpose of this meeting was to discuss the Louisiana Uniform Construction and Building Code and the hiring of a building official. She then stated the floor was open for discussion. President Barrios then recognized Mr. Robert Glass, Director of Public Works, from the Caddo Parish Commission who briefed the Jury as to what Caddo Parish was doing concerning the Uniform Construction and Building Code. President Barrios then told the Jury about what Webster Parish was doing concerning the same matter. After a lengthy discussion, it was agreed that the Parish Administrator would draft an ordinance similar to Webster Parish and present it at the next meeting of the Police Jury.

President Barrios then asked Juror Cloud to say a prayer before adjourning the meeting.
