

PROCEEDINGS OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE  
NATCHITOCHES PARISH POLICE JURY HELD THURSDAY,  
OCTOBER 4, 2007 AT NINE (9:00) A.M.

The Police Jury of the Parish of Natchitoches, State of Louisiana, met in special session in the Police Jury Board Room of the Natchitoches Parish Courthouse, on Thursday, October 4, 2007, at nine (9:00) o'clock a.m.

The invocation was given by Juror J. D. Garrett followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Juror Tom Collier.
